
Field of Interest Account

What is a Field of Interest Account?

Field of interest funds create grants that address the needs in a particular field or geographic area of interest.

How can a Field of Interest Fund help achieve my charitable goals?

Donors can direct their gift to address an important area of the community (animal welfare, arts & culture, basic human needs, civic enrichment, community health, education, parks & recreation, veterans services, and youth development).



Establishing an Account

- 1 Decide when to give**
Donors may create an account now, establish a bequest through a will, or include the fund in a charitable trust arrangement that benefits the donors' family as well as charity.
- 2 Decide what to give**
Almost any kind of asset can be used to start an account, such as cash, publicly traded securities, closely held stock, interests in limited partnerships, real estate, life insurance, tangible personal property, retirement plan distributions and private foundation assets.
- 3 Choose the name for your account**
Most accounts are named for the founding donor, the donor's family or as a memorial after the loss of a loved one.
- 4 Choose a type of account**
Endowed Fund – The principal of the account remains in perpetuity. Investment income provides grants in the donors name forever.

Expendable Fund – The corpus of the account can be distributed in its entirety, once all of the funds have been distributed, the account will be closed.
